


# Patient Instructions for Drive Up Testing



Duke Primary Care is offering drive up testing to limit the possible person-to-person spread of COVID-19. For your safety and the safety of our staff and providers, please adhere to the following:

1. Everyone must stay in car. Do not attempt to leave vehicle and enter collection area.
2. Advance your car into the testing area, as directed by staff.
3. **Do not touch** the gowned staff at any time. A circular icon with a blue border and a white background. Inside, there is a blue hand with fingers spread, and a diagonal red line with a white border crosses over it from the top-left to the bottom-right, indicating a prohibition on touching.
4. When prompted for collection, follow the instructions provided by the staff. The procedure may be uncomfortable.
5. Please follow guidance provided by the ordering entity regarding quarantine guidelines while awaiting test results. All individuals should limit their contacts, wear masks, and stay 6 feet away from others. Some individuals may be required to quarantine while awaiting results, while others may not.
6. Test results are typically available between 1-5 days depending on where the test is processed and the reason for testing. If you have a positive COVID test, you will be contacted by your ordering provider, and your county health department for contact tracing. If you have Duke MyChart, your results will be viewable as soon as they are available. If you do not have Duke MyChart, a member of your care team will contact you with your test results.

**Important:** If your condition dramatically worsens, or you become short of breath, contact your healthcare provider or 911.
