Wear a mask to keep those near you safe.

These masks and hand sanitizer are for you. You should wear a mask when you are in the community, walking to and from your car, waiting for the bus or riding on the bus. Make sure to sanitize your hands and practice physical distancing when possible.



- Before touching your mask, wash or sanitize your hands. Save this bottle and refill.



- **Duke-issued medical earloop masks** must be worn by team members working in our hospitals and clinics.



- **Cloth masks** may be worn in any building where there is not a formal screening process and no direct patient care. Acceptable cloth masks should completely cover the nose and mouth.

- All masks should be appropriate for the workplace; masks with any phrases, sayings or emblems are not permitted.
- Make sure to safely store your mask. Remove your mask by the elastics. Fold it lengthwise so that the outer surface is against itself and place in a clean paper bag or paper towel.
- **All Duke Health employees must wear a mask in our facilities.**
